JUDGMENT: APPLICATION LEAVE TO APPEAL

GUSH, J:

- [1] The second applicant in this matter has filed a notice of application for leave to appeal against the ex tempore judgement which was handed down on 15 February 2013 in which judgment I dismissed the applicant's application with costs.
- [2] In response to the second applicant's application for leave to appeal the third respondent simply filed a notice "Opposing of Leave to Appeal" (sic).
- [3] The applicant has set out in its application for leave the grounds upon which it relies and upon which the application for leave to appeal is based.
