1. This trial needs to be postponed, by agreement, solely because the defendant served a notice under Rule 28(1) of its intention to amend its plea substantially.
2. This notice, served two days before trial, is extremely late and attracts a punitive costs order. The parties agreed orders 1-4 below.

ORDER

1. The matter is postponed sine die.
2. The defendant is to deliver its application to amend its plea by 30 May 2025 at 4pm
3. The plaintiff may deliver its opposing affidavit by 13 June 2025 at 4pm.
4. The defendant may deliver its replying affidavit by 20 June 2025 at 4pm.
5. The defendant is to pay the plaintiff's wasted costs of trial on the attorney and client scale, including those of counsel.
