JUDGMENT – WRIGHT J

1. The first applicant, Mr Reichman and the first respondent, Mr Bronstein have been in business together. They are in serious dispute now relating to a company in which they both have a 50% interest, namely RBP, the second respondent. RBP is the owner of Trigz, the third respondent.
2. In effect, Mr Reichman now seeks urgently to interdict Mr Bronstein from running Trigz.
3. The papers are long and complicated and the business relationship between the two men is intricate.
4. Mr Reichman lives in New York. He says that Mr Bronstein, who has day to day control of Trigz, is siphoning money out of Trigz.
5. There is pending, an application launched by Mr Bronstein in December 2025, for the winding up of RBP based on the deadlock between the two men.
6. Mr Bronstein says, in a detailed answering affidavit, that he has made payments only in the ordinary course of business and that Trigz is making record profits.
7. There are huge disputes of fact which cannot be decided on the papers.
8. Mr Bronstein says that once RBP is wound up, a liquidator could sell the asset of RBP, namely Trigz or its business, as a going concern.
9. The launching of the present application, apart from the clear animosity and distrust between the two men, would itself appear to ground a case for the winding up of RBP.
10. In my view, no urgency is shown, particularly given that the relief sought now could be, in effect, obtained by a winding up of RBP.
