JUDGMENT – WRIGHT J

1. Ms Phangisa instituted action as plaintiff against the defendant close corporation.
2. The claim, as set out in the particulars of claim, is for R15 950 000, interest and costs.
3. Mvulazana takes exception to the particulars of claim on the ground that they do not disclose a cause of action.
4. The particulars of claim, signed by Ms Phangisa herself are in the form of a lengthy, complicated affidavit. There may, somewhere in the document, be a cause of action but if there is it is so heavily camouflaged by other matter, in the form of what appears to be a long history of dealings with a person with whom she did business, that a clear cause of action is not readily discernible.

Order.

1. The exception is upheld with costs, including those of counsel. Scale C applies.
2. The particulars of claim are set aside.
3. The plaintiff may deliver fresh particulars of claim by 31 March 2026 at 5pm.
