JUDGMENT – WRIGHT J - LEAVE TO APPEAL

1. On 16 March 2026 I heard an opposed application and handed down a typed, signed judgment.
2. Fedgroup had launched motion proceedings, seeking a money judgment, against the present applicants for leave to appeal.
3. I found in favour of Fedgroup for the reasons set out in my judgment.
4. The applicants' case boils down to the suggestion that they never have to pay unless they can borrow elsewhere. This is unlikely.
5. In my view, the present applicants do not have a reasonable prospect on appeal nor is there compelling reason why an appeal should be heard.

ORDER

1. The applicants' applications for leave to appeal are dismissed.
2. The applicants are jointly and severally to pay the respondent's costs, including those of senior counsel. Scale C applies.
